

# **Piano Practical Examination Day Checklist**

## **Before you Leave Home**

- $\checkmark$  Plan to arrive 15 minutes early.
- ✓ Complete your Examination Program Form.
- $\checkmark$  Bring original copies of all the music being performed in the examination.
- ✓ Mark the pieces being performed with a paper clip or a "sticky note."
- ✓ Wear proper shoes (pedaling, for example, can be difficult with some types of shoes).

#### **Points to Remember**

- Electronic devices, books, notes, bags, and coats must be left in the area designated by the presiding officer.
- $\checkmark$  Photo ID may be requested before candidates are admitted to the examination room.
- $\checkmark$  There are no warm-up rooms for piano candidates.
- ✓ Parents, other family members, friends, and teachers must wait in the designated waiting area.
- ✓ Standing and listening outside the examination room door is prohibited.
- $\checkmark$  Recording devices are strictly prohibited in the examination room.
- ✓ Photocopied music is prohibited (unless authorized by the publisher).
- The performance of repertoire may be interrupted by the examiner once an assessment has been reached. An interrupted performance does not indicate a poor performance.

#### What to Expect from an Examination

- $\checkmark$  A friendly yet professional atmosphere.
- $\checkmark$  The undivided attention of an examiner.
- ✓ An objective assessment of your performance of repertoire, studies/etudes, orchestral excerpts, technique, ear training, and sight reading.
- $\checkmark$  The examiner's written evaluation online within six weeks of the examination.
